RJC architects gets \$54 million contract

RJC Architects, a San Diego-based architecture and planning company, announced the award of a \$54.5 million contract to design and build the Marine Corps Special Operations Command (MARSOC) headquarters at Camp Pendleton.

RJC, in partnership with **RQ Construction Co.** of Bonsall, will design an 89,000-square-foot headquarters building and a 21,000-square-foot academic instruction building at the 33-acre MARSOC complex located within the 125,000-acre Marine base.

The headquarters building will include command offices, an auditorium, a medical department and a secure compartmentalized information facility.

The MARSOC complex will also include vehicle maintenance facilities, an armory, a paraloft and a supply warehouse, which will be designed and built by RQ Construction.

The project will break ground in December 2008 and is slated for completion in 2010.

In addition to the MARSOC headquarters, RJC, under project manager Michael Cather's direction, is also planning and designing a \$14 million lodging facility at Camp Pendleton.

The new 50,662-square-foot, four-story lodge will include 69 ocean view rooms and suites, a landscaped courtyard and children's play and picnic areas.

RQ Construction is also constructing the Lodging Facility, located on Stuart Mesa.

Some of RJC's most recent projects include Coronado's new \$30 million City Hall and Community Center and the \$31 million renovation of the historic Del Monte Hotel at the Naval Post Graduate School in Monterey, Calif., and the new \$531 million San Diego County Operations Center.

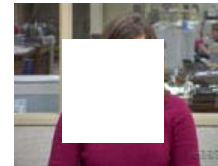
